

# Font Demonstration

The following extract is part of a song by Stuart Ardern used in the children's play *I'll See You In My Dreams* by Michal Y Noah.

The text is presented in the ubiquitous Times New Roman font and also in Primer Print, which should be closer to handwriting as taught in early years classes.

## Times New Roman version

### *Scene 2 – Lakeside*

**(Chorus of turtles sunning themselves; fish swimming. Hoppy enters from one side of the stage, Mommy and Dad enter from the opposite side. They wave and meet in the middle to watch the turtles and fish.)**

#### **Song 1: At the Water's Edge**

**Turtles:** We are turtles, splishy splashing

Jumping into the lake

*Plop*

Each one hurtles, mud slide belly flop

See what waves we can make

*Plop*

**Fish:** We are fishes, swimming, shimmering

Where the water is cool

*Splosh*

Grant our wishes, come and play with us

In our paddling pool

*Splosh*

## Primer Print version
